The Rother Valley Family

Amberley CE School and St James' CE School, Coldwaltham work together as the **Arun Villages Federation**, sharing an executive headteacher and a governing body. To the west, Graffham CE Infant School and Duncton CE Junior School are the **Lavington Park Federation**; children aged 4-7 are taught at Graffham whilst the 7-11 year olds attend Duncton. The schools, three miles apart, also share a headteacher and governing body.

Together, Rake CE Primary School, Rogate CE Primary School and Compton and Up Marden CE Primary School make up the **Downland Village Schools Federation**, with two governing bodies, one representing Rake & Rogate and the other representing Compton and Up Marden. The three schools share one executive headteacher. Most recently, the two primary schools at Stedham and Harting have entered into a soft federation, becoming the **Weald and Downlands Schools Federation** with separate headteachers and governing bodies.

Stedham Primary is a small, rural school with 4 classes rated Good by OFSTED in January 2018. We offer an exciting curriculum including regular d trips to enhance learning. Our school on independence, motivation, creativity,
