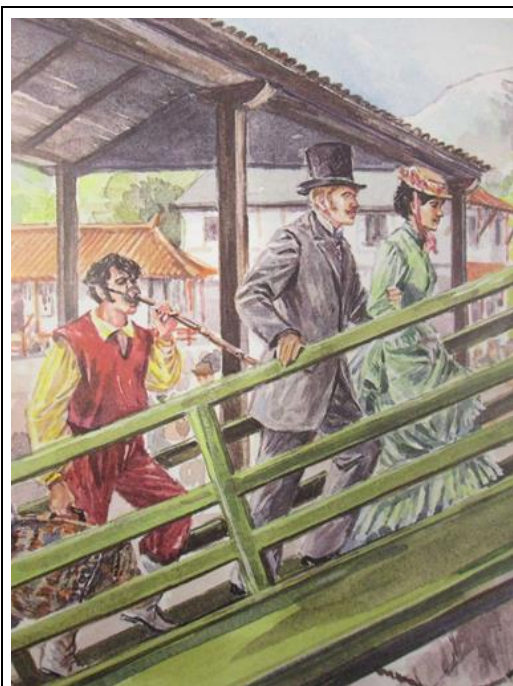


Around the World in 80 Days - Buzzard Class (Year 5 and 6)



Around the World in 80 Days is primarily a geography topic

Literacy, communication and language

Key text - Around the World in 80 Days by Jules Verne.

Poetry from around the world with a focus on poetic techniques.
Information texts on countries presented as a blog, travel agent, etc.
Narrative writing using Jules Verne's writing style, characters, settings.
Persuasive writing:

French: This is France and let's visit a French town.

Personal, social and emotional development

Attraction to others, romantic relationships, civil partnerships and marriage, recognizing and managing pressure, consent in different situations, expressing opinions and respecting other points of view, including discussing topical issues.

Mathematics

Place value - comparing and ordering larger numbers, rounding integers, counting in powers of 10, negative numbers.

Addition and subtraction - adding and subtracting more than 4 digits, multi-step problems.

Multiplication and division - multiples, multiplying and dividing by powers of 10, short and long multiplication, factors, short and long division, prime numbers, cube numbers, square numbers, order of operations, estimation and approximation.
Fractions: equivalent fractions, simplifying fractions, converting mixed numbers to improper fractions and vice versa, number sequences, adding and subtracting fractions, multiplying and dividing fractions, finding fractions of amounts,
