- I will engage in non-fiction books to learn more about the world around me

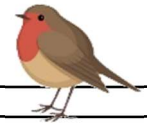

Physical Development (PD)

- I will learn how to keep myself and others safe around fireworks and bonfires
- I will continue to make daily use of the outside learning environment to develop my overall body strength
- I will continue to develop my upper body strength to engage the muscles needed to sit with good posture at a table or on the carpet
- I will continue to use a range of malleable materials in my play and 'Funky Fingers' sessions to develop my fine motor skills in preparation for writing
- I will join in with weekly PE sessions



Understanding the World (UW)

- I will learn all about the Hindu festival of light, Diwali
- I will make my own diva lamp and rangoli patterns to explore how Hindus celebrate Diwali
- I will understand how different people celebrate special times in different ways
- I will learn about the Nativity and why it is important to Christians
- I will be exploring the question – why do Christians perform Nativity plays at Christmas?

Literacy (L)

- I will continue to develop a love of reading through daily shared stories
- I will enjoy looking at books and talking about them with a grown up
- I will enjoy performing familiar stories and stories of my own in my play
- In phonics I will continue to learn my letter sounds and how to write them
- I will start to blend the sounds into words so I can read short words that contain the letter sounds I know

Mathematics (M)

- I will continue to enjoy singing songs and rhymes that consolidate my counting and ordering of numbers to 5
- I will be learning about the numbers 1-5 in great depth to give me a strong foundation for my maths learning
- In my counting I will be able to say which number is one more or one less than a given number
- I will begin to be able to answer questions such as, '*who has the most counters?*' '*How many more counters do we need to fill the frame?*'

Expressive Arts & Design (EAD)

- I will use a variety of artistic effects to express my ideas and feelings to create fireworks pictures
- I will use my knowledge of rangoli patterns to explore and make my own repeated patterns
- I will continue to take part in imaginative play through the role play area, developing storylines and working collaboratively with my friends
- I will continue to take part in music lessons to explore instruments and sing familiar songs
- I will perform in our Christmas performance at St. Luke's
